**Snacks:** AYS strives to serve nutrient-dense snacks and children will be encouraged to try new foods. A snack menu is posted at the program. Children with food allergies must have a completed Plan of Care form on file with AYS. *AYS participates in the Child and Adult Care Food Program. There will be no discrimination during snack service.*

**Homework:** Children will have between 10 and 30 minutes (depending on grade level) of homework time/support Monday through Thursday. A variety of reading materials or quiet activity stations will be available for children without homework assignments. Each Friday, homework time will be replaced with extended enrichment activities related directly to the core curriculum areas.

**Break Camps:** AYS offers one or two locations in IPS for fall, winter and spring break camps. Advance registration is required and break camp tuition is billed separately.
